

PSC Covid Shooting Rules, rev2 Mar4, 2021

Masks shall be worn at all times when inside the shooting building or passing by others entering or exiting the building. Masks may be removed only when seated at the shooting tables and ready to shoot.

Except for paragraph three, no more than 5 shooters on the firing line per each relay along with one Range Officer. The following shooting tables will be used: #1 #3, #4, #6 and #8.

Whereas, clear vinyl separator sheets have since been installed between tables, then all shooting tables may be used. And masks may be removed for shooters who are seated and ready to shoot. Masks will be worn when finished shooting and stepping away from the shooting tables.

Everyone who is not shooting will keep out of the shooting hut whenever a relay prepares to shoot, shoots, and removes their shooting equipment.

After the shooters from each relay have departed the shooting hut to go outside, the next relay may come in to set up their equipment.

All persons not currently shooting must stay outside and keep 6ft apart. Masks must be worn whenever this minimum distancing cannot be followed. This applies to Target Changers.

Disinfection bottles will be available for shooting tables, seats, etc.

Shooters must have their own masks, and hand sanitizers. Hand sanitizing bottles will be available should someone forget theirs. You must have your own mask.
