GENERAL INFORMATION

- Registration** Check daily programs for registration times.
- Pre-Squadding** Pre-squads for all Events must be cashiered or released at least one hour before the scheduled start time for the event. Pre-squads not cashiered or released by the deadline will be cancelled and opened to all shooters. There will be a \$20 per event re-squadding fee for any shooter who holds a position for any of these events and does not cashier it or release it prior to the time required above. The only exception allowed will be for those who have pre-squadded the event and it is their first event of the tournament.
Pre-squad payments will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- Entry Payment** In general, only cash, or cheque will be accepted as payment. Some host clubs may accept credit card.
- Shells** Reloads will be permitted at this tournament. Check with your host club if factory loaded shells will be available. A valid firearms licence is required to purchase shells.
- Juniors** Some Provincial Associations have special pricing for Targets and Trophy fees for Junior and Sub-Junior shooters on the 400 Championship Targets ***provided that they do not play any purse or option in any event.*** They must pay however all applicable CTA, ATA and their Provincial Association fees.
- Alcohol** Shooters are reminded of ATA rules that prohibit consumption of alcohol or drugs during participation in any event or sub-event or between events or sub-events, including shoot-offs.

GENERAL INFORMATION

(Continued)

Singles & Handicap Events	All Singles and Handicap events will be shot 5 targets per post, 100 targets on 2 to 4 traps depending on the host club.
Doubles Events	All Doubles events will be shot 10 targets per post, 50 pairs on 1 or 2 traps depending on the host club.
Shoot-offs & Carry-overs	<p>All Singles ties will be carried over to following like event. Carry-overs will be based on succeeding 25 target sub-events until a winner is determined. Any unresolved carry-overs will be resolved by shoot-off at the conclusion of the Singles Championship on Saturday. Singles shoot-offs will be on rounds of 25 targets until a winner is determined.</p> <p>Ties in any Handicap event will be shot-off at the end of each day. All Handicap shoot-offs will be on rounds of 25 targets until a winner is determined.</p> <p>All Doubles ties will be carried over to the following like event. Carry-overs will be based on succeeding 50 target sub-events until a winner is determined. Any unresolved carry-overs will be resolved by shoot-off at the conclusion of the Championship events on Sunday. Doubles shoot-offs will be on 10 pairs until a winner is determined.</p> <p>Because of the time-zone differences for this championship, shooters with the highest scores in each championship event might have to shoot in advance 2 to 4 rounds.</p>
Cashiering	All cashiered entries are final. No entries or options will be refunded unless the event is cancelled.
Pay-Outs	If offered, all purses and options will be paid out at the conclusion of the shoot by the host club.
Targets	ATA approved targets will be used for all events.

SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITY

Be Ready to Shoot

Squads will not be allowed to wait for tardy members. Shooters will have 3 minutes to take the line once the previous squad is finished. No shooter will be called to the line. It is the responsibility of each shooter to watch squad progression on their bank.

In Singles and Handicap, once the lead-off shooter has completed his/her first post of the first sub-event, shooters will not be allowed to join the squad until the next sub-event. Shooters will not be allowed to join their squad after the second sub-event. **Shooters who miss two sub-events must either forfeit or re-squad for the event and pay a \$20 re-squadding fee.** If shoot management elects to shoot 10 per post, shooters will not be able to join their squad after the lead-off shooter has completed his/her first post **and must either forfeit or re-squad for the event and pay a \$20 re-squadding fee.**

In Doubles, once the lead-off shooter has completed his/her first post of the first sub-event, shooters will not be allowed to join the squad **and must either forfeit or re-squad for the event and pay a \$20 re-squadding fee.**

Make-ups

All make-ups will be shot at the make-up trap. Shooters must report to the make-up trap within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the event. Shooters will not be paged or searched for. Failure to report to the make-up trap on time will result in the shooter forfeiting that event. **No shooter will be allowed to make-up more than 50 targets on the make-up trap. Shooters who miss more than 50 targets with their squad will be required to re-squad for that event. A \$20 re-squadding fee will apply.**

Gun Breakdowns

In case of a gun breakdown, the shooter will be allowed 5 minutes for repair or replacement. Have your tools and parts or a spare shotgun with you if you are at all concerned about this possibility. Your squad will not be allowed to wait more than 5 minutes for you. There will be no exceptions. If you cannot rejoin your squad in this

Gun Breakdowns (continued)	time frame, you will have to make-up your remaining targets on the make-up trap. Please note that no shooter will be allowed to make-up more than 50 targets on the make-up trap. <i>Shooters who miss more than 50 targets with their squad will be required to re-squad for that event. A \$20 re-squadding fee will apply.</i>
Check your scores	Check your scores before leaving each post and at the end of each sub-event. Any changes to scores may only be made in strict accordance with ATA rules.
Earned Yardage	Shooters earning yardage in any Handicap event must report to the Classification Desk to have your Average Card punched.

CLASSIFICATION AND HANDICAPPING

Classification will be based on known ability. Known ability will be based on official averages, non-registered scores and any other information bearing on a shooter's ability to shoot and break targets. Shooters are required to have their 16-yard and doubles averages computed prior to registration. Shooters who present an Average Card without all targets recorded and/or without averages being calculated ***will not be classified until the card is completed or may be assigned to a class or yardage at the discretion of the classifier.***

Shoot management reserves the right to review all scores in any Singles or Doubles event on the first day of this tournament for classification purposes. Shooters under review may be moved to a higher class at the discretion of shoot management. Classification changes made during the shoot will be posted on the score board area and will be considered official when posted.

A shooter who holds an ATA card and a card from another clay target sport association must produce ALL such cards to the classifier. Failure to produce all cards may result in disqualification at the discretion of shoot management.

Penalty Classification and Yardage

Singles – A shooter who has less than 1000 total 16 yard targets registered [with the ATA and PITA combined for the current and previous two years will be assigned to “B” class or higher at the discretion of the classifier.

Doubles – A shooter who has less than 1000 total Doubles targets registered with the ATA and PITA combined for the current and previous two years will be assigned to “B” class or higher at the discretion of the classifier.

Handicap – A shooter will shoot his or her ATA or PITA yardage, whichever is the longest. **All Male except Sub-Junior and Sr Vet** who have less than 1000 total Handicap targets registered with the ATA and PITA combined for the current and previous two years will shoot from assigned yardage or Average Card yardage, whichever is longer. Assigned yardage will be no less than 23 yards. All other shooters who have less than 1000 total Handicap targets registered with the ATA and PITA combined for the current and previous two years will shoot from assigned yardage or Average Card yardage, whichever is longer. Assigned yardage will be no less than 20 yards.

Classification Move-Up

Shooters winning or tying for class in Singles and Doubles events will advance one class.

CANADIAN CLASSIFICATION

Any person born in Canada or is a permanent resident of Canada will be allowed to shoot as a Canadian resident.

NOTICE TO SPECIAL CATEGORY SHOOTERS

Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub-Veteran, Veteran and Senior Veteran, shooters must declare their special category at the time of classification in order to be eligible for special category trophies. ***It is the responsibility of special category shooters to ensure that their special category has been noted on their entry form prior to cashing for the first event entered.***

RULES AND REGULATIONS

This tournament will be governed by the rules of the Amateur Trapshooting Association. Every person who enters the competition agrees to abide by the rules of the Amateur Trapshooting Association ***and*** the terms of this Program ***and*** to accept all decisions of shoot management. The CTA, the Provincial Association and the host club will not be responsible for any accident, loss or theft that occurred during this competition.

Except for the Closed Champion Trophy in events 4-5-6 and HAA that are supplied by the ATA, all other trophies are supplied by the CTA. All trophies will be mailed to the winners directly.
